Volunteer Basic information and Rules

MUST HAVE A BADGE TO VOLUNTEER!

Hayride begins Friday October 1st 2021

Open every Friday, Saturday and Sunday

Hours of operations are from 7pm till 10pm

Prices: Combo \$15 Hayride \$12 Maze \$8

If we are busy we will extend the hours for that night.

Volunteers are expected to stay until the last trailer is in and for the Maze till your told it's being shut down for that evening.

Volunteers must stay at their designated spot, if you must leave inform the person who is in charge.

We ask that all volunteers to arrive as early as possible to make sure everything is operational and in tip top shape.

If there is bad weather we will post on social media.

-Makeup-

Start time 5pm till 6:30pm

Try to be there by 4:45pm.

NO Badge **NO** Makeup!

-Food-

Get it before 7pm and at the end when the hayride closes. You can bring your own.

Dress appropriately it gets cold and damp!

-Temporary Badges-

Start at 5:30pm

Will be given to anyone that does not have one.

To get a temporary ID you **MUST** have a current ID (License, State or School)

NO ID **NO** Badge!

Your ID will be collateral and at the end of the night it will be given back to you when you hand in the temporary badge.

There is a \$5 fee if you lose the temporary badge.

If you have a permanent badge and you lose that your required to get the temporary.

-Requirements for volunteering-

Age 16 or 17 you need a permission form signed by a legal guardian or parent and they also need ID and proof of guardianship, (Birth certificate etc.) No other family member can sign.

Age 18 and up just need ID

RULES:

Remember we are still in a pandemic crisis, these rules MUST be followed!
